FUTURE FOR CHILDREN (FFE) e.V. is a registered charity in Germany that provides direct aid in the form of housing and education to orphaned children. FFE is also registered in Kenya with a recognised certificate known as a Charitable Children Institution.

As a small, independent organisation we provide support for orphaned children and the problems they face on a daily basis. The ultimate goal is to provide support and guidance to allow them to lead independent lives as they enter adulthood.

Future for Children has built an orphanage on a large plot of land on the South Coast of Mombassa (In the Mvindi Area). We provide the children with a perspective for their future by securing their basic needs, i.e. providing regular meals, clothing, medical care and health education as well as general education. We develop their talents, arrange recreational activities in their spare time and give them guidance and support in the search for employment as appropriate.

A HOME!

The orphanage and Makemba Academy (School) is situated in an area of 10 000sqm. 18 children have found a home and a future in the orphanage. Traumatized young children are allocated to us where we bring them up in a family-like environment. They attend our Kindergarten and the school next door, the school provides them with an excellent education and prepares them for further education, or University, for which Future for Children also provides financial support. In order to provide a healthy and varied diet, we have our own allotment for growing various vegetable and fruits (e.g This is made possible by our rainwater reservoir. We feed the Makemba Academy (children and teachers) daily with their National breakfast (Ujii) as well as Lunch. The external school Children are transported safely on a daily basis with our own School Buses. All the children attending our school are provided with basic education. We have workshops for furthering skills and creativity to help the children to achieve and take responsibility for an independent future. We have a large sports field at our disposal for the children's' physical education.

It is our mission to offer the children suitable accommodation, a home and most importantly an independent future, by raising and educating them to lead an independent and happy life.

OUR HISTORY!

The manager of this project, Maren Kehler, visited Kenya during the 1990's on a number of occasions. It was during these trips that she realised the extent of the orphan problem and need for a solution in Kenya, especially for the children. She became actively involved initially in the funding-raising and building of an orphanage. Friends and family supported her financially but many sort to dissuade her given the scale of the problem. However, Maren persevered and with the help and financial support of family and friends and her own assets, bought a plot of land near Ukunda. She had it prepared as a building plot, prepared some of it for arable farming and fenced it off. She drilled a well to supply the fresh water and went to great lengths to get an electricity supply. A large part of the funds raised in Germany and across Europe were through indigenously made products, shipped and sold in markets in Europe. The majority of the products were designed and produced by Maren. Financial support was also gained through cultivating land for the small farm where Maren grows vegetables and keeps farm animals from which the neighbouring families were able to profit. The Orphanage was opened in 2010 and the School (Makemba Academy) in 2014. Approx 250 children are educated in the School and 36 Kenyans (male and female) have gained work from Maren (Support staff for the orphanage, farm workers, teaching staff and admin staff, dressmakers, cooks, kitchen staff, and bus drivers).

Maren's commitment to caring for others and her unwavering energy in making FFE a success is an inspiration to all of the Kenyans involved in the orphanage and school. As family and friends we are grateful and forever proud of Maren.
